Members of the Tuscaloosa Co Sheriff's Office became aware of the fact that a fugitive warrant was issued by the Department of Corrections for Terry Ray Snow aka "Tico". The Sheriff's Office received further information he was believed to be in the Buhl community. A Sergeant coordinating the setup of surveillance in the area observed a vehicle matching the description that Snow was believed to be in.

At approximately 9:30 pm on Tuesday August 3rd, 2010, deputies initiated a traffic stop on Shelley Hughes Rd. in Buhl and found Snow to be an occupant of the vehicle. Deputies were able to take Terry Ray Snow, W/M, 45 years of age into custody. He was also charged with Possession of Drug Paraphernalia based on the traffic stop from last night.

Patrol Deputies were assisted in last night's arrest by the Aviation Unit and Sheriff's Sergeant assigned to the Homicide Division as well as the US Marshals Fugitive Task Force.

Sheriff Ted Sexton said, deputies involved in this arrest did an outstanding job of gathering information, setting up the surveillance and apprehending an individual with an extensive criminal history without incident. Snow is believed to be a suspect in at least one murder, James Tilley in Tuscaloosa County and Lisa Jones in Greene County.
